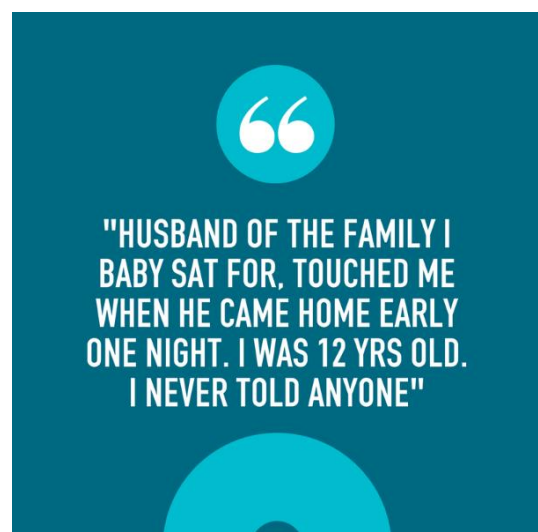
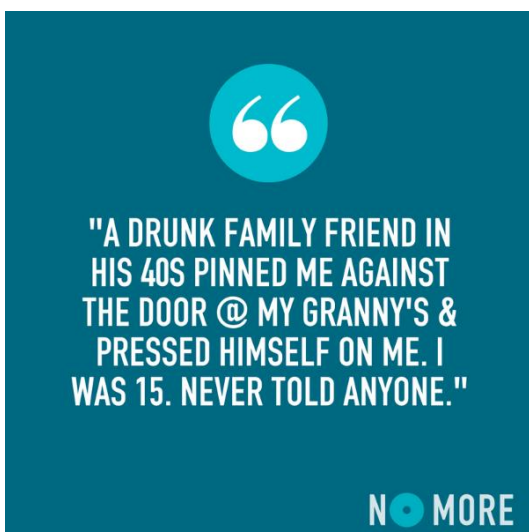


Not Backing Down: 'Locker Room Talk' is #NotOkay
