Seal Press Commits to Domestic Violence Awareness with Yearlong Ebook Promotion

Summary: In support of Domestic Violence Awareness Month this October, Seal Press has reduced the price of four domestic violence resource ebooks to \$0.99 for a full year.

BERKELEY, CA. (October 7, 2014): In 1982, Seal Press published *Getting Free: You Can End Abuse and Take Back Your Life*, the first in a series of handbooks for women in abusive relationships. Now, more than thirty years later, this bestselling handbook remains relevant and necessary.

One in four women (24.3 percent) and one in seven men (13.8 percent) aged 18 and older in the United States has been the victim of severe physical violence by an intimate partner in their lifetime. Intimate partner violence alone affects more than 12 million people each year.

In support of Domestic Violence Awareness Month this October, Seal Press has reduced the price of four domestic violence resource ebooks to \$0.99 for a full year at participating ebook retailers: *Getting Free, Stop Signs, Helping Her Get Free,* and *You Can Be Free.*

Throughout the year, Seal Press will be spearheading a comprehensive publicity and marketing campaign in order to reach survivors, support groups, shelters, social workers, and therapists, encouraging them to share these low-cost handbooks as potentially lifesaving resources. A dedicated ereader device isn't necessary to read the promoted ebooks; titles can be read on tablets and mobile phones using any reading app, many of which are free.
